A Nursing Faculty position may include course planning and instruction in classroom, campus laboratory and clinical settings. Qualifications include a master's degree in Nursing from a recognized, regionally accredited college or university. At least two years of recent registered nursing experience is required. Medical surgical experience is preferred. West Virginia RN licensure or eligibility for such licensure is required. Successful college-level teaching experience is preferred, as well as an aptitude for using technology in instructional delivery and a willingness to deliver courses online. Demonstration of teaching effectiveness is part of the on campus interview.
